## POLECAM V1.1

I was looking for a good polecam that was retractable so I could travel with it round South America for various sports/adventure filming. So here it is:



- 1) Shows the pole retracted and is  $600 mm\ long\ fully\ retracted.$
- 2) Shows the pole extended and is 1200 mm long fully extended.
- 3) Shows the mounting

It can be extended to any length between 600 and 1200mm and locked into place.

All together it cost roughly \$40.

POLE: From Bunnings and originally was a tree piece telescopic window cleaner ( $\sim$ \$7). I cut the 3<sup>rd</sup> telescopic section out because I didn't think it needed to be longer than 1200mm. the pole came with a rubber/foam handle. I picked up another bit of this foam/rubber stuff and used one for the handle and the other for shock absorbing padding by cutting it in half and double layering it on the end of the pole. I fixed the padding into place with 2 cable ties.

MOUNTING: Official GoPro handle bar mounting. \$30 from ebay. I just clamped the mounting over the shock absorbing foam.

CLAMP: Although the pole "locks" into place by twisting it I found it was still a bit wobbly so got a hose clamp from Bunnings ~\$3.
